The main function of salt in cake recipes is to enhance the flavor of the other ingredients. Its presence perks up the depth and complexity of other flavors as the ingredients meld. Salt also provides a balance to the sweetness of cake batters—but a salty flavor should not be discernible.

You can reduce the salt according to your taste, but if you leave it out completely, you'll likely find your cakes taste a little "flat."
